What is TIM?

Transclick Instant Messenger (TIM) is an IM chat tool for language translation.
Specific features include:


- * Support for 6 languages and translation over email or on-screen
- * Full Jabber compatibility
- * Integrates seamlessly with Google Gtalk.

What is my Server name?

The server name is **next.transclick.com**

How do I register for TIM?

Whether you are using TIM on cell phone or desktop computer, the signup process is the same. Have a look at Picture 1 to see the signup screen.



If you don't have an account, register here - Your ID will be your User Name.

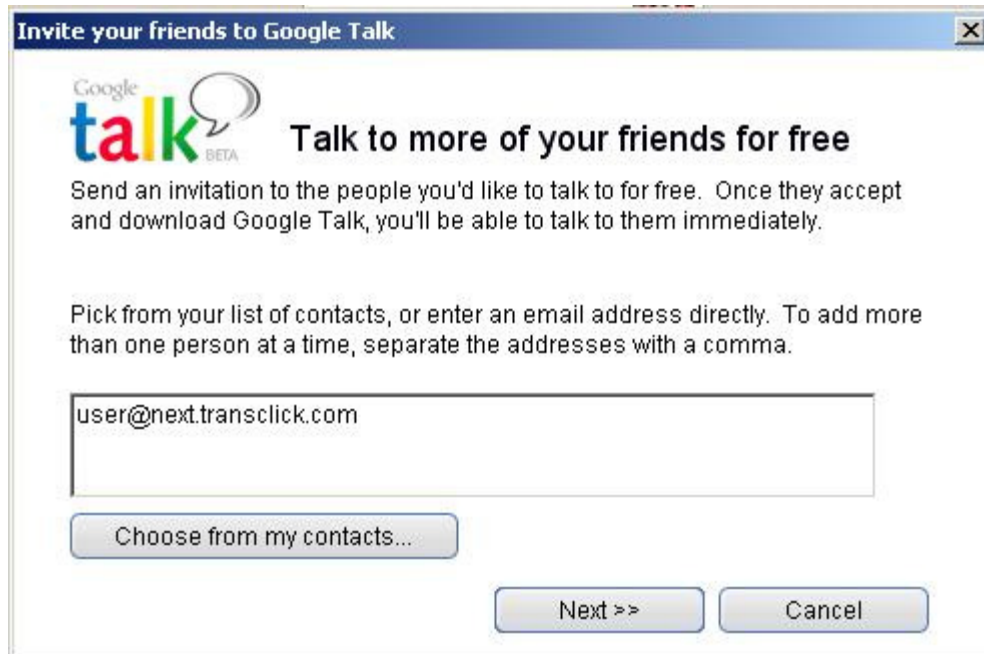

How to I invite a friend in TIM?

Have a look at Picture 4. This shows the invitation from GoogleTalk to user@next.transclick.com who is the local TIM user. Picture 5 shows an example of the invitation acceptance window.

How do I Chat in TIM?

Look at Picture 6 to see a real TIM conversation going on. User dino777 is sending instant messages to a Spark IM user English. The recipient is receiving the message in the original English, and the translated Italian.

In-Band vs. Out-of-band clients.

At least ONE MEMBER of a TIM conversation MUST be using an **in-band client**. An **In band client** allows you to specify our TIM server which is **next.transclick.com** . It is generally a generic Jabber client. A list of such clients can be found at <http://xmpp.org/software/clients.shtml> . Picture 7 shows you the server-name entry field for iJab.
